The use of recycled raw material is actively encouraged and this currently accounts for over 80% of the company's output. All raw material waste generated by the process is channelled back through the manufacturing 'loop' for subsequent recycling.

The company is committed to continuous energy reduction initiatives and investment in lowest energy plant and equipment along with continuous investment in the latest technologies. The company adopts a continuous improvement and cost down strategy to ensure long term benefits for our customers and the environment.

Storage and distribution logistics are optimized in an effort to reduce our carbon footprint and impact on the environment.
